

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 26

The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Seismic Resilience and Fire Prevention Ordinance."

SECTION 2. EARTHQUAKE-READY MATERIALS AND FOUNDATIONS. Due to the high seismic risk of activity in the City of Young and the wider County of Cenoz, all new buildings and all remodeled buildings are required to include earthquake-ready materials and foundations.

SECTION 3. CALIFORNIA FIRE CODE COMPLIANCE. All new buildings and all remodeled buildings are required to be up to date with the California Fire Code to prohibit the spread of fires.

SECTION 4. REINFORCEMENT OF OLDER BUILDINGS. Additionally, all older buildings, including those that are made of unreinforced concrete or masonry, are required to be reinforced within the next two years.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and commence immediately upon passage.
