

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 27

The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Fire Abatement Ordinance."

SECTION 2. BRUSH ABATEMENT AND INSPECTION. All private property owners are required to abate all unlandscaped brush on their property by May 31st of each year. All such properties are subject to inspection by the fire department.

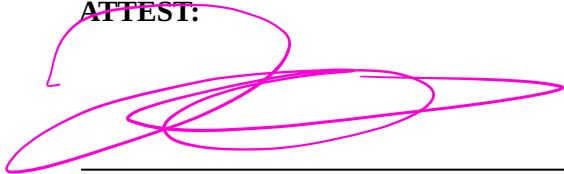
SECTION 3. FINES AND ABATEMENT AUTHORIZATION. Failure to comply with abatement requirements results in a \$100 fine per day. The fire department is authorized to hire abatement personnel on the owner's behalf and charge the costs to the owner if the property is not brought into compliance.

SECTION 4. HIGH FIRE RISK SEVERITY ZONES. Additionally, all property along a high fire risk severity zone is required to have a fire break built that can be paid by the fire department's grant funds.

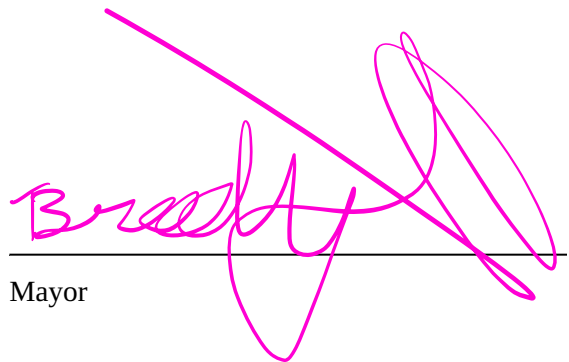
SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and commence immediately upon passage.
