

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 30

CITY OF YOUNG

COUNTY OF CENOZ, CBGS

The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Grace Tech High School Naming and Zoning Ordinance."

SECTION 2. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE. The City Council finds that the existing high school facility located within the City Hall District has undergone extreme physical deterioration and can no longer safely, efficiently, or adequately meet the academic and structural needs of the community. In accordance with the California Education Code guidelines and municipal urban planning standards, the City requires a modern facility to serve its growing population and ensure geographical equity in public infrastructure.

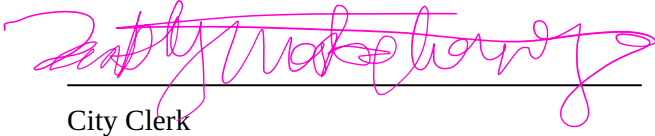
SECTION 3. ESTABLISHMENT AND NAMING OF GRACE TECH HIGH SCHOOL. To remedy the deficiency on the western side of the municipality, the newly constructed secondary educational facility situated on the western edge of the city is hereby officially designated, established, and named "Grace Tech High School."

SECTION 4. REGIONAL COORDINATION OF SECONDARY EDUCATION. Grace Tech High School shall function as the primary municipal high school serving the western edge of the city. To ensure balanced institutional resources, its operations and student capacity shall be complemented by the newly renovated Diorio High School, located on and serving the eastern edge of the city.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and commence immediately upon passage.
