

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 13

The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "City of Young Anti-Littering Ordinance".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE AND PROHIBITION.

To protect the public health, safety, peace, and welfare of residents, and to preserve the aesthetic and environmental integrity of the community, the City of Young hereby strictly prohibits littering. No person shall dump, deposit, drop, throw, discard, or otherwise leave litter, rubbish, debris, or waste material upon any public streets, sidewalks, parks, municipal easements, or private property within the corporate limits of the City of Young.

SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES.

Violation of this ordinance constitutes an infraction. Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be assessed a fine of \$100.00. Should a defendant assert an inability to pay the fine, the Court shall conduct a financial evaluation. If the Court evaluates and determines the defendant is unable to pay, the defendant shall be assigned to perform public service, the nature, location, and terms of which shall be determined at the will and discretion of the City Council or its appointee.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

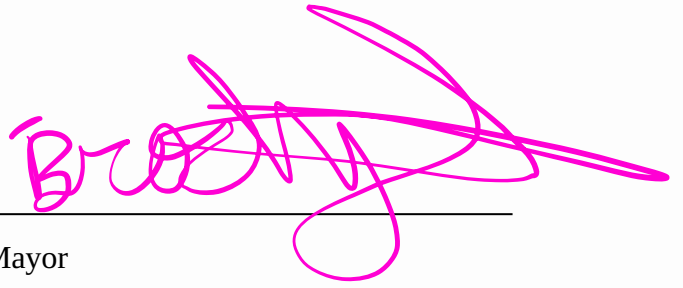
This ordinance shall take effect and commence immediately upon passage and adoption.
