

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 21

The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Mandatory Snowball Break Ordinance".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE AND MANDATE.

To promote civic morale, physical activity, and community well-being, the City of Young hereby mandates that in the event of any measurable snowfall within the corporate limits of the City, there shall be a mandatory thirty (30) minute snowball break. This mandate applies to all municipal employees of the City of Young, as well as to any person present in any city-registered company or business operating within the City limits.

SECTION 3. EXEMPTIONS AND SAFETY.

Emergency services personnel, including police, fire, and emergency medical services, may stagger or delay their mandatory snowball break to ensure continuous protection of public safety and health. Furthermore, snowball activities must be conducted in a safe manner that does not result in damage to public or private property.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect and commence immediately upon passage.
