

CITY RESOLUTION NO. 23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YOUNG REJECTING COUNTY SECESSION AND DECLARING LOYALTY TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

The City Council for the City of Young hereby resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND DECLARATION.

The City Council finds that the County of Cenoz is contemplating or attempting an unauthorized and unconstitutional secession from the State of California and the United States of America. The City of Young categorically rejects any such action and declares its unwavering intent to remain a loyal, incorporated municipality within the State of California.

SECTION 2. POLICY ON MUNICIPAL JURISDICTION.

In the event that the County of Cenoz formally adopts any measure to secede, the City of Young hereby establishes as its official policy that it shall refuse to recognize the county's secession. The City shall take all necessary legal and administrative steps to sever political ties with the rogue county government and maintain direct jurisdictional alignment with the State of California.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

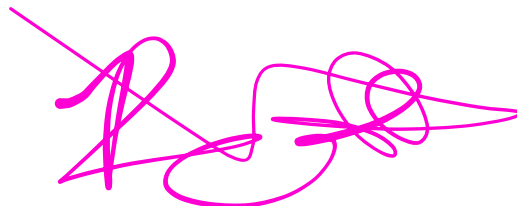
This resolution shall take effect and commence immediately upon its passage and adoption.
