**EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2026-01
EMERGENCY CLOSURE OF COURT OPERATIONS DUE TO DISASTER**

WHEREAS, the physical facilities of the Superior Court of California, County of Cenoz, have sustained heavy and severe structural damage as a result of a sudden emergency disaster, rendering the courthouse unsafe for personnel, litigants, and the general public; and

WHEREAS, such extensive damage fundamentally impairs the Court's ability to safely conduct standard operations, manage active dockets, or secure constitutional access to justice safely within the damaged facility; and

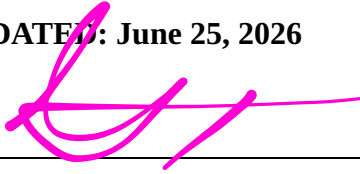
WHEREAS, Government Code Section 68115 and the inherent powers of the Judiciary grant authority to the Presiding Judge to take necessary, temporary administrative actions to preserve public safety and the integrity of the judicial system during an extraordinary emergency or disaster;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. TEMPORARY CLOSURE:** All physical operations of the Superior Court of California, County of Cenoz, are temporarily suspended and closed effective immediately.
- 2. EXTENSION OF DEADLINES:** Pursuant to emergency judicial authority, any days during which the court is closed under this order shall be deemed a holiday for purposes of computing time under the California Code of Civil Procedure, California Penal Code, and California Rules of Court.
- 3. DURATION:** This order shall remain in full force and effect until such time as necessary repairs are completed to restore structural integrity to the facilities, or until the Presiding Judge declares that the immediate emergency disaster has officially ended.
- 4. NOTICE:** The Court Clerk is directed to post copies of this order on all digital channels and at alternative municipal entry points where feasible.
