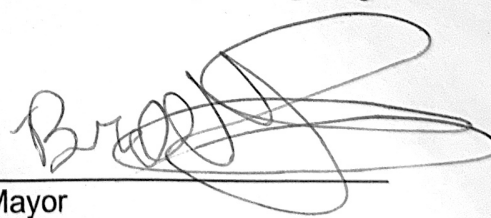


CITY ORDINANCE NO. 3

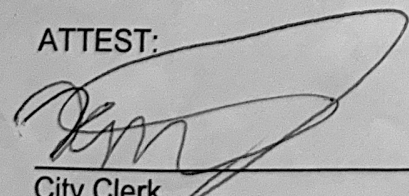
The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

Any person who knowingly, willfully, maliciously, or ~~or~~ negligently damages, destroys, uproots, or otherwise tampers with any plant, tree, shrubbery, or flowerbed shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subjected to a \$10 to \$20 fine, 5 minutes of incarceration in the City Jail, ~~or~~ 3 hours or session blocks of community service, or all of the above in any combination. Any person who commits criminal destruction of Public Beauty, who cannot pay the fine, shall not have the fine imposed. This shall be, the act, named "Criminal Destruction of Public Beauty."

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Young, County of Cenoz, CBGS, as an Ordinance at the regular meeting of the City Council held on June 22, 2026.
