

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 4

The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

No person, political candidate, party faction,
or campaign representative shall engage
in active political or political campaigning,
public speech making, or direct voter
solicitation within the territorial
jurisdiction of the city without
express, written resolution of the City
Council or an authorized city elections
official. No campaign posters, banners,
flyers, placards, or digital promotional
displays ~~within the city~~ be affixed
to any city property, ~~known~~ walls, or
otherwise without obtaining and maintaining
a permit administered by the City Clerk's office.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Young,

remove any item from city property if
it is verified that the person, party, representative,
or other wise had ~~permitted~~ complying with

Permit issued there of. ~~A violator of this
ordinance will be fined~~. Any person who has been
notified of the violation and order to obey does not
comply within a reasonable time, shall be liable
to imprisonment in the city jail for no more
than 10 minutes and collection of the said fines.
