

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 7

The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. GROUNDS AND EASEMENT TOLL.

To better provide funding for the maintenance of grounds that are used by citizens of all different cities and counties, the City of Young hereby implements a toll of \$1.00 for any person who travels across any grounds or easement within the City of Young's limits.

SECTION 2. ISSUANCE OF TOLL PASSES.

The City Council hereby issues thirty-eight (38) unlimited use toll passes to the Young Justice Group. These passes shall be fully valid until 11:59 PM on Saturday, June 27, 2026.

SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT AND EVASION FEE.

This ordinance shall be strictly enforced twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week. Any person found to be evading the toll established in Section 1 shall be assessed a fee of \$50.00 per offense.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

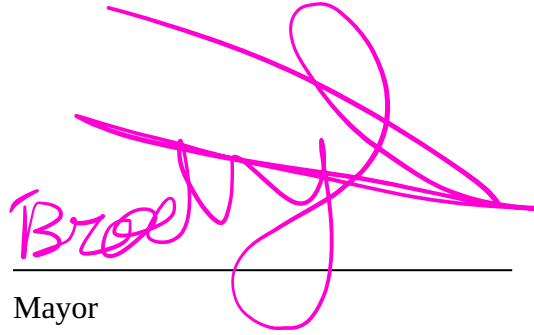
This ordinance shall take effect and commence twenty (20) hours after the physical placement of toll notification signs at the respective grounds and easements.

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 8

The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as "The anti-speaker boy ordinance".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE AND PROHIBITION.

To protect the peace and welfare of citizens by preventing high-volume noise disturbances, the City of Young hereby prohibits the operation of personal audio devices (including Bluetooth speakers, megaphones, and portable radios) on any public grounds, roads, sidewalks, or municipal easements within the corporate limits if they produce a noise disturbance plainly audible twenty-five (25) feet from the source, without prior approval.

SECTION 3. EXEMPTIONS AND PERMIT PROCESS.

Individuals may apply for an exemption permit via the City Clerk. The City Council or its appointee shall approve permits based on objective, content-neutral criteria, denying requests only if the sound disrupts scheduled municipal operations, occurs between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM, or exceeds safe decibel thresholds.

SECTION 4. ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES.

Violation of this ordinance constitutes an infraction. Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be assessed a fine of \$50.00. Should a defendant assert an inability to pay, the Court must conduct a financial assessment; if found unable to pay, the defendant shall be assigned to public service determined at the discretion of the City Council or its appointee.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect and commence immediately upon passage.
