

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 28

The City Council for the City of Young hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Flood Control Infrastructure and Resilience Ordinance."

SECTION 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT. There is hereby established the Young Flood Control District, an administrative body operating under the authority of the City of Young municipal government.

SECTION 3. DISTRICT JURISDICTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Young Flood Control District shall exercise immediate authority and municipal oversight regarding the management, programmatic operation, maintenance, and structural repair of all public storm drains, piping systems, pumping stations, and sea wall barrier protection infrastructures located within the municipal boundary limits of the City of Young.

SECTION 4. CIVIL INFRASTRUCTURE RATING STANDARDS. All newly constructed, modified, repaired, or deployed flood control equipment, conveyance channels, structural defenses, and municipal drainage infrastructure components managed within the city limits shall adhere to a minimum mandatory engineering standard rated to survive or withstand at least a 100-year recurrence weather event cycle.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and commence immediately upon final passage.
